



Camp Conduct Agreement Form

For your information, we expect each student to conform to these rules of conduct:

- No possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco
- No students can drive once they have arrived and registered at camp
- No fighting, weapons, fireworks, lighters, or explosives
- No offensive or immodest clothing (No 2 piece swimsuits)
- No boys in girls' sleeping quarters and No girls in boys' sleeping quarters
- Participation with the group is expected
- Respect property
- Respect one another, staff, and adult leaders
- Respect and comply with event schedules

Students who fail to comply with these expectations may be sent home at their parents' expense.

I, the student, have read the rules of conduct, the above evaluation of my health, and permission to participate in youth group activities. I agree to abide by the stated personal limitations and code of conduct.

What will happen when this contract is violated:

If an incident occurs where a camper conducts himself/herself in a manner that jeopardizes his or her safety, the safety of others, or is not in accordance with the mission of the IAYM Youth Ministries, the following steps will be taken.

- Staff member will intervene immediately and discuss possible solutions to the problem with the camper
- IAYM Youth Ministries and camper will discuss solutions to the problem
- Phone call to parents/guardian concerning the problem
- Camper is sent home
