

Health Forms

Campers must have completed health forms. Health forms are part of the registration form and must be completed at time of registration for your child's camp. Parents of children needing special care (diets, medications, etc.) should write IAYM Youth Ministries (indicate which camp).

Medical

To meet all insurance requirements, prescription medications MUST be in original pharmaceutical containers, with dosage outlined on the bottle.

Insurance

Our camper insurance begins where yours ends. It is only valid when your policy has been extended to its limit. Parents are responsible for payment and arrangement of treatment and prescriptions while the child is at camp.

Registration Confirmation

Once campers have completed the registration process, a confirmation of their application will be sent via e-mail. If no e-mail is available, you will receive paper copy in the mail. This confirmation will include the director contact information, as well as an emergency contact phone number and a mailing address for the week of camp. Deposit and Cancellation

50% of camp registration fee must be sent for camper's registration to be processed. If cancellation is made 15 days prior to the beginning of the camp you are scheduled to attend, you are ensured of a full refund. Registration Deadline is May 23rd 2008. **A \$25 late fee will be required for all registrations postmarked after May 21st.**

Bunk Mate

Part of the camp experience is meeting and building community with new people. Therefore IAYM Youth Ministries guarantees only one bunk mate. **Both campers must have each other's name on registration for this guarantee. No more than two campers from the same church will be in a cabin.**

Canteen

Canteen is available twice daily for campers. There are assorted candies, sodas, and snacks for a reasonable cost.

Meals

Due to the high amount of activity that takes place at CQH, campers are encouraged to eat something at each meal.
